

### State-wise green open access regulations

Following the notification of Green Energy Open Access Rules, 2022 and its amendments, the Ministry of Power requested ‘all States/UTs to take appropriate action for implementation of the Electricity (Promoting Renewable Energy through Green Energy Open Access) Rules, 2022 (as amended from time to time) notified by the Central Government and align Open Access Regulations, on aggregation basis, in accordance with the notified Rules, at the earliest’<sup>1</sup>. The current scenario regarding the notification of the various state’s green open regulations are tracked below:
