Context

India's electricity consumption, one-third of the global average per capita, is growing rapidly to meet the development aspirations of over a billion people India's power sector has significantly evolved over the past two decades: near-universal electrification, a five-fold increase in renewable energy capacity and marquee changes in market design.

India must reliably and affordably meet the rising electricity demand with a clean grid. This unique journey will be marked by the swift and continuous expansion of renewables and other clean energy resources across states. India's ability to pivot its power market to serve this renewed purpose will determine the success of this transition.
